
required by the National Voter Registration Act of 1993). LWVGB is part of a coalition checking thousands of voters who were purged from Jefferson County rolls. See information below on how to volunteer. In anticipation of special legislative races in Shelby County on July 13, June Fletcher and I will be organizing registrations next month at America's Thrift Store in Alabaster and at Orr Park in Montevallo on June 12th. Dana Ellis and Nancy Sales are working with Firehouse Shelter staff to post VS information and meet with clients who may need League assistance. Church of the Reconciler, which also provides assistance and ministry for unhoused clients, now has voter registration and restoration information to hand out. Birmingham will have municipal elections in August, and city neighborhoods are already sprouting candidates' signs. We will have outreach opportunities in the metro area later this summer.

What we will accomplish in the coming year is <u>your</u> decision. A membership quorum is required to do business, so Members, please make every effort to <u>register</u> and attend.

These are the business items that we will consider. The proposed program, budget, and bylaws changes are as recommended by the LWVGB Board. The slate is as recommended by the LWVGB Nominating Committee. Please read these before the meeting and be prepared to discuss and vote.

- **Program** Decide LWVGB issue positions, studies, and issues for emphasis for the coming year.
- •. Budget* Decide how we should spend our LWVGB funds.
- •. Bylaws* Decide on proposed changes in the laws that guide our actions. Here is draft of bylaws if all changes are adopted.
- •. <u>Slate of Board of Directors and Nominating Committee</u> Decide who you want to lead our League in 2021-2022 and recommend future leaders. Also, see this issue of *The Voter* for the report of the current Nominating Committee.
